



Tournament Rules

The laws of the game of association football shall apply with the exception of the no offside, with the U7's & U8's the back pass will be permitted. All age groups will play 6 a side and are permitted 2 substitutes who will be roll on - roll off with the consent of the referee.

Players may only play for the team they are registered with at the start of the tournament. Failure to comply with this rule will result in the offending team being disqualified from the competition.

In the event of a player receiving a caution, they will miss the next match. Should a player receive 2 cautions or be sent off, then will not take any further part in the competition.

3 points will be awarded for a win and 1 point for a draw. In the event of a tie on points, placing will be decided by:

- Goal Difference
- Most Goals Scored
- Head to Head Result
- Penalties (3 per team then sudden death)

The duration of all group matches will be 10 minutes straight through (no half time). Semi finals and finals will be 6 minutes each way. (Some age groups may vary)

In the event of a draw in the semi final or final extra time will be played and the golden goal rule will apply. The first team to score during extra time will win the match.

In the event of extra time, no substitutions shall be allowed and on the referee's instruction 1 outfield player or goalkeeper from each team must be removed after every 1 minute of play until a minimum of 2 players remain for both teams.

Any point not covered by these rules will be referred to the tournament coordinator, whose decision is final.
